Dear Parent(s):

Please be advised that insurance is not automatically provided with student issued Chromebooks. Therefore, the Rosendale-Brandon School District is offering an insurance option through Worth Ave. Group. Information regarding available insurance options can be found on the reverse side of this letter. The insurance portal for enrollment, <https://gpo.worthavegroup.com/gpo/rbsd/> will be open from August 1, 2018 thru September 15, 2018. When enrolling, the “device id number”, is the number that is etched on either the top or bottom case of the device, e.g.. LAC-2018-001 and the serial number (for Acers and Samsungs) or the service tag number (for Dells) is located on the bottom of the device.

Please also be advised that the Chromebooks that the sophomores, juniors and seniors will lease during the 2018-2019 school year will no longer have a warranty. The new Chromebooks that the freshmen will lease during the 2018-2019 school year will have a one year warranty covering hardware and mechanical failure only. Accidental damage, including, but not limited to drops and/or spills, will not be covered under the warranty. Non-warranty repairs will incur a cost of which the student will be responsible. If the repair is covered by Worth Ave. Group, the student would only be responsible for the deductible amount, if any.

Worth Ave. Group is an insurance option offered by the Rosendale-Brandon School District. However, feel free to contact your own insurance carrier regarding possible insurance coverage options.

Please be advised that the insurance only covers the device it was intended for and does not cover loaners made available when a student’s device is out for repair. If there is any damage to the loaner, the student will be responsible for its repair.
