### **Before & After School Procedures**

To increase student safety, please review the information below with your child.

ALL students (grades 4K-8) who ride a bus to Brandon School will enter the building via the main office doors at 7:45.

ALL students (grades 4K-8) who walk to school will enter the building via the Bowen Street entrance at 7:45. Supervision begins at 7:40am, so walkers should not arrive at school prior to that time.

ALL students (grades 4K-8) who are dropped off in the morning should be dropped off on Bowen Street and enter through the Bowen Street entrance at 7:45. Please remember that this is a drop off zone in the morning and a pick up zone in the afternoon; no parking is allowed. Supervision begins at 7:40am, so students should not be dropped off at school prior to that time. Supervision ends at 3:30pm. Parents -- please do not use the main parking lot in the morning unless you have to enter the building.

Thank you for your help improving safety for our students.

**Nutrition Note:** Students are highly encouraged to bring, and carry throughout the day, approved water bottles filled with only water. Other beverages are not allowed.

Absences: If your student (grades 4K-8) needs to be absent, please leave a message for the Brandon School office by calling 346-2915 by 9am. Please note you are able to leave an attendance message 24 hours a day. Middle school students should use the pre-excused absence form (available in the office and online) when they are aware of absences in advance.

### School Day

Remember that school starts at 7:55am. Please have your student in the building with enough time to be in their classroom at that time so as not to disrupt the class by arriving late. Also school dismisses at 3:20pm. Please remember to have arrangements in place each day for your child at this time as there is no after school childcare. If there will be a change in your child's normal transportation, please remember to call the office before lunchtime so there is time to make sure that we can get the message to your child and their teacher.

YOUR PARENT POWERSCHOOL ACCOUNT – Not so long ago, we asked you to create a Single-Sign-On account so that you can view all of your children's PowerSchool accounts with only one log in, rather than having one for each child. That enabled you to see your child's attendance, grades and fees. Now, PowerSchool has migrated those items with your child's classwork. It's called Unified Classroom. We ask that you take a moment to create a new account that will enable you to see all these things, again with just one log in. To get started, watch this 4 minute video that explains how to do so, then go to the district website to begin the process.

- This process also pertains to parents who only have one child attending our schools.
- Access to PowerSchool is no longer possible. All access is now via Unified Classroom.
- Parents who are also staff members must use a personal email address when creating this account.

### Volunteer Application

All parents or family members chaperoning a field trip or helping in the classroom, will need to have a volunteer form filled out and approved by the District Office before the event. If you were approved within the last five years you do **NOT** need to reapply. If you applied more than five years ago, you would need to submit another application.
