Parent Teacher Conferences

Parent Teacher Conferences will be held at Brandon School on Monday, October 8th from 4:00-7:30pm. Elementary teachers will be contacting parents to schedule appointments for elementary students. Not all parents will have a conference during this time. There will be another conference day coming up on October 16. Again, the elementary teachers will be contacting you to set up the appointment for this date.

The Middle School (grades 6-8) have an open house format. You may stop in anytime from 4:00-7:30pm.

After-School Homework Help

After school homework help with a certified teacher is available most days from 3:20-4:15 for students in grades 4-8. Students who wish to participate should report to the teacher's room by 3:40. This is a voluntary resource for students who would like some extra help with their assignments or a quiet place to do homework after school. The schedule for the first few months of school is attached and is posted in various locations at school for students' reference. (Attachment: After School Homework Help)

Homework is expected to be done at home and completed before the due date. When middle school students come to school with incomplete or poorly done homework, they are required to attend "homework club" during their lunch/recess to finish it. This is not intended to be a punishment; rather, it is a structured time for them to catch up on important skill practice. If students repeatedly are required to attend due to poorly done/incomplete work, parents are notified via a Notice of Concern sent by email.

RBEL Program at Rosendale Primary

RBEL (Rosendale-Brandon Early Learners) is a free program designed specifically for you and your 3 year old child. It is a chance for you to bond in an academic environment and to help prepare you both for 4K. This evening is strictly for you and your 3 year old child (no siblings please). One or more parents/guardians must accompany their 3 year old. The RBEL program will begin next Tuesday, October 2nd in the 4K classroom at Rosendale Primary School. Power School for Parents
