Reminder of Upcoming Important Dates

Inclement Weather Make-up Time - a note from Mr. Weber:

Due to the crazy weather we've had this winter, we have the need to make up a portion of the instructional time we've lost so far. To date, we've missed 6 complete days due to weather with an additional 2 hours for a late start. The Department of Public Instruction has requirements regarding the number of hours of instruction not the number of days of instruction. Therefore, we will be looking at increasing our hours of instruction.

Here's the current plan for adding instructional time:

- Beginning on March 4 we will be increasing the minutes of instruction at each building. Brandon, Rosendale Intermediate, and Rosendale
 Primary students will begin their days at 7:50 a.m. and end at 3:21 p.m. Laconia and Cirrus High School students will begin at 7:53 a.m.
 and end at 3:31 p.m.
- March 8 was scheduled as an early dismissal day. This will now be a full day of school for students in grades 5K-12. This day will
 remain as originally scheduled for our 4K families.
- Should we need to have any late starts, early dismissals or complete cancellation of school days moving forward, we would make up that time Thursday, April 18. Currently, that day is part of our Spring Break.

Please note that this is the current plan. Weather in Wisconsin can change at any moment, which means we may need to make further changes to the calendar. Attached is a revised Master Calendar indicating the change to March 8. (Attachment: Revised 2018-2019 School Calendar)
