CHANGE IN START AND END TIME OF SCHOOL DAY EFFECTIVE MARCH 4 - Due to the crazy weather we've had this winter, we have the need to make up a portion of the instructional time we've lost so far. To date, we've missed 6 complete days due to weather with an additional 2 hours for a late start. The Department of Public Instruction has requirements regarding the number of hours of instruction not the number of days of instruction. Therefore, we will be looking at increasing our hours of instruction.

Here's the current plan for adding instructional time:

• Beginning on March 4 we will be increasing the minutes of instruction at each building. Brandon, Rosendale Intermediate, and Rosendale Primary students will begin their days at 7:50 a.m. and end at 3:21 p.m. Laconia and Cirrus High School students will begin at 7:53 a.m. and end at 3:31 p.m. March 8 was scheduled as an early dismissal day. This will now be a full day of school for students in grades 5K-12. This day will remain as originally scheduled for our 4K families.
