Over the past few days, we have experienced acts of violence in Wisconsin schools that are upsetting to all of us-parents, students and staff. We would all like to pretend that occurrences like that would never happen in our area. Yet, this week they did. Our thoughts go out to the Oshkosh and Waukesha communities as they work through those incidents.

Coincidentally, while the Oshkosh West situation was occurring on Tuesday, we were practicing our responses to an active intruder in each of our four buildings. Practicing responses for an active intruder event is unsettling for staff and students alike, but situations like those that happened closeby this week remind us why it is important for us to do so.

We want our students and staff to feel safe at school. By practicing these types of drills, our students gain confidence in how to respond to a crisis. Our students benefit from reminders of safe practices in order for them to make good decisions regarding their personal safety.

We all hope that we never face situations like those we saw this week, but we know it is a possibility. We also know that positive relationships are extremely important and help deter behaviors like this. We want all students to feel safe and welcome in our schools and work diligently to ensure this. I thank you for your continued support and encourage you to contact us if you or your child have any safety concerns.
