HELP US HELP YOU

As you are aware, the State of Wisconsin along with the rest of the nation is navigating its way through the COVID-19 (Coronavirus) pandemic. Many families and individuals are experiencing a reduction in hours worked or even their jobs temporarily suspended, leaving them with less income for their household finances.

The Rosendale-Brandon School District recognizes this and encourages all families who have been affected to fill out the Application for Free and Reduced Price School Meals. Although it is uncertain at this time when school will resume, if your family's income falls within the Federal Income Eligibility Guidelines, your child's meal cost will be set at the new price for the remainder of this school year and for the first 30 days of school come next fall. It may not seem like much, but you may be surprised on how much you may save. If your family qualified for reduced meals, the cost is \$.40 per day or \$2.00 a week, which is a \$10 to \$12 savings per week per child. If your family qualified for free meals, the savings would even be greater. Please do not wait until the start of the new school year to apply for the Free or Reduced Meals. You may be eligible now! Any time during the school year when a family's income is reduced or a member is added, it is to the family's benefit to fill out an application.
