## Summer School 2021 Registration Link

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The Emergency Broadband Benefit (EBB Program) was recently created as part of the 2020 Consolidated Appropriations Act. It will provide a discount on eligible consumers' internet bills of up to \$50/month, and \$75/month on Tribal Lands. Families who qualify will need to apply for the benefit using the National Verifier application. We expect the application portal to open for consumers on April 26th. Families that receive Medicaid, SNAP, and other benefits will qualify and be able to opt-in to the EBB program through the National Verifier application. Some families will need to upload to the National Verifier proof of attending a CEP school or

qualifying for F/R lunch in 2019-20 or current school year when they apply. Please click on the link above to learn more about the program.
