Elementary & Intermediate School Administrators Designated

John Hokenson will be the principal at both Rosendale Primary School and Brandon Elementary School. Mr. Hokenson has many years of experience as an elementary principal and his teaching experience is in elementary education. He also has much experience as a “traveling” principal.

Leanne Greff will be the building principal at Rosendale Intermediate. While she has served as an elementary and middle school principal for a number of years, her teaching experience is at the middle and high school levels. A concern shared by a number of parents was the transitioning their child from Brandon to RI and the anxiety that may cause. Having a familiar face in charge of the building (as well as the Brandon Middle School teachers who are moving over) should help mitigate the concern over transition.

Both principals are meeting weekly to work through transition plans in order to best serve our student and district needs. More information will be communicated out by them as those plans are developed.

The Rosendale Brandon School District will be changing the way students access their PowerSchool account. Previously, students had a four letter username, as of March 23, 2021, all students will begin using their Chromebook username. This change will help students remember their PowerSchool account and improve PowerSchool integration with other applications.

Examples:

If their Chromebook login is [doejane@rbsd.k12.wi.us](#), their PowerSchool username will be doejane.

or

If their Chromebook login is doejohn32@rbsd.k12.wi.us, their PowerSchool username will be doejohn32.

This will NOT affect their passwords, only their usernames. If students or parents forgot their PowerSchool passwords, they should contact their school's office.
