Freshmen and Sophomores: All freshmen and sophomores will be participating in the state-required ASPIRE testing during the last three weeks in April. I recently met with all students to distribute a schedule of testing days/times. The ASPIRE is a computer-based test that measures students' post-secondary academic readiness in the areas of math, science, reading, language arts and writing. These assessments provide students and teachers with valuable information on skills that are needed for success on the ACT test during the junior year.

Sophomores: Sophomores will also be participating in the state-required Wisconsin Forward exam. This is a computer-based test in which students are tested on their knowledge of social studies. The Forward exam will take place during students' regularly scheduled World History course on May 10th and 11th.

Juniors: Most juniors have received a paper report of their ACT scores by mail. If you are interested in taking the test over at your expense, you can register at the following website: www.actstudent.org. You will sign into your MyACT account to complete registration. The next national test date is June 12th with a registration deadline date of May 7th. ACT research shows that 50% of students who choose to re-test increase their score by an average of two points. When you register, you can choose the "ACT No Writing" option and save yourself some money as long as you are happy with your writing score.

AP Students: Advanced Placement tests will take place during the first administration phase, which runs from May 3-17. Students may contact their AP course teacher for their specific exam date as well as practice tests. They may also find sample questions at apcentral.collegeboard.com.
